

Curio Privacy Policy V 2.0

Last Updated: 2/12/25

Introduction.

Curio., and all wholly own subsidiaries (“Curio” “we” or “us”), respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it to those who use our services (“you” or “user(s)”).

This Privacy Policy (the “Policy”) describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit our online gaming website and platform and our practices for collecting, storing, sharing, transferring, disclosing, and using certain information about our users.

By using the Curio website or application (collectively, the “Services), specifically the game on www.duper.gg, or by submitting any personal information to us you consent to this Privacy Policy. If, for whatever reason, you object to the practices defined in this Privacy Policy, you may not use the Curio website or application.

This Policy applies to all the information we collect from you, or that you may provide, when you use the Services, including:

- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this Website.
- Through mobile and desktop applications you download from this Website, which provide dedicated non-browser-based interaction between you and this Website.
- When you interact with our advertising and applications on third-party websites and services if those applications or advertising include links to this policy.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by the Company or any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries); or
- Any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries), including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or through the Website.

This Policy is to be considered a part of the Terms and Conditions. In the event of a conflict between this Policy and the Terms of Service, the Terms and Conditions shall prevail.

Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, and compliance therewith, your choice is not to use the Services. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this Policy. This policy may change from time to time (see Changes and Updates to this Privacy Policy.). Your continued use of the Services after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of such changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It.

We collect several types of information from and about users of the Services, including information:

- **Personal Identifying Information** - You are required to register an account to use the Services. During the account registration process and upon request thereafter, you may be required to enter personal information such as your legal name, residential address, date of birth, social security number (or last 4 digits), email and telephone number. Other information that may be required during the use of the Services includes, but is not limited to, credit/debit card numbers, bank account numbers, geolocation information, driver's license number, your photograph and demographic information. During the registration process and during your use of the Services is when we collect personal information from you. By providing your Personal Identifying Information and registering with us or using the Services, you expressly consent to the collection, processing, and disclosure of your Personal Identifying Information for the purposes described in this Policy.
- **Geolocation Information** – In order for us to legally offer our services to you, we are required to confirm that you are physically located within a state where our website is legally available. We collect your location information by using a third-party geolocation service. We are required to store and retain your location information in accordance with applicable law and internal policy.
- **Correspondence** - Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses) if you contact us.
- **Research** - Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes.
- **Transaction Logging** - Details of transactions you carry out through the Services.
- **Search** - Your search queries on the Website.
- **Know Your Customer (“KYC”)** - We may receive information from a third-party provider through our Know Your Customer (“KYC”) process in efforts to protect you from harm such as anti-money laundering, fraud.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with the Services, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to the Services, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use with the Services.

- Information about your device and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking).

The information we collect automatically may include personal information and or may just be maintained or associated with certain personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve the Services and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize the Services according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to the Services.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- **Cookies (or browser cookies).** A 'cookie' is a small text file containing small amounts of information which is downloaded to your device when you visit a website or use applications. We use a number of different cookies on Duper.gg to help us to recognize you, track your activity and improve your use and experience of Duper.gg. In addition, we use a number of third-party service providers, who also set cookies on Duper.gg, in order to deliver the services that they are providing to us. Such services include, but are not limited to, helping us to improve your use and experience of Curio by tracking your activity on Curio, measuring the effectiveness of Curio and the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns. The cookie enables the server to collect information from the browser. We may use the following types of cookies:

- **ESSENTIAL COOKIES:** Cookies that are essential to the running of Duper.gg. Without the use of cookies, Duper.gg may not function properly. For example, when logging in to your account a session cookie is created to allow you to browse the site and play games;
- **ANALYTICAL COOKIES:** We use analytical cookies to monitor the performance of Curio and to determine how visitors use the site. These cookies provide us with information that helps us create better products for our users and to identify areas that may need maintenance. We currently use Google Analytics, a popular web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics uses cookies to help us to analyze how players use Duper.gg. We also use analytical cookies from additional third-party providers;

- **PERSISTENT COOKIES:** These are saved on your computer for a fixed period and are not deleted when the browser is closed. Such cookies are used where we need to know who you are for repeat visits, so the correct language is presented and to improve our users' experience of the Website as well as present different marketing messages and advertisements for existing users;
 - **FUNCTIONAL COOKIES:** Functional cookies are used to remember your preferences on Curio, enhancing the user experience. This can have a range of functions such as remembering your username or recording that you have read a site message so you don't need to view it again;
 - **SESSION COOKIES:** Session cookies are used by the server to store information about user page activities so users can easily pick up where they left off on the server's pages.
- **Pixels:** We also use pixel-based tracking to track a visit or event on the platform and to track advertisements' impressions. This information is also used by us for remarketing purposes and for tracking conversions that are used to optimize our marketing activities. We may share such information (which is non-personal information) with our advertising and marketing partners. By accessing and using Curio, you consent to the placement of cookies and pixels on your device in accordance with this Notice.

Third-Party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Some content or applications, including advertisements, on the Services are served by third-parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you use the Services.

The information they collect may be associated with your personal information or they may collect information, including personal information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content.

We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. If you have any questions about an advertisement or other targeted content, you should contact the responsible provider directly.

How Curio Uses Your Personal Information.

It is our goal to use the personal information we gather through your use of Curio's website or mobile application to further enhance your gaming experience. Such use of personal information to better your experience shall include, but is not limited to:

- To present the Services and its contents to you;
- Preventing any unauthorized participants from using the Curio website or application;
- Customizing your experience based on preferences that you provide;
- Notifying you of certain events, games, or services that we deem may be of interest based on the preferences you set;
- With your prior consent, posting any feedback you provide regarding your use of the Curio website or application;
- Assessing whether you are enjoying the Duper.gg website or application in a responsible manner. If we identify any patterns of potentially problematic use of the Curio website or application, we may reach out to you to offer resources that may assist you enjoying the services responsibly;
- Creating single or aggregated data based on the personal information you provide for any purpose.
- Sending marketing materials regarding the services and or services of any third-party company that we advertise on Duper.gg website or application.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or any products or services we offer or provide through it.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We will retain all personal information that we collect through your use of Curio's website or application for as long as we deem it necessary to achieve the goals laid out in the "How Curio Uses Your Personal Information" section above, unless we are required by law to keep it for a longer period of time. We reserve the right to back up certain information for security reasons for a longer period than the original information.

Disclosures of Personal Information.

While protecting your personal information is a top priority, there are certain instances where we are obligated to disclose the personal information we receive or collect. We reserve the right to disclose such information to our subsidiaries, any affiliated companies, agents, or service providers who are responsible for processing your personal information to assist us in our operations. These other companies and service providers may be responsible for, but are not limited to, KYC processing, geolocation verification, payment processing, promotional services, and technical support. Where possible, we have entered into agreements with all such companies and service

providers to ensure that the use of your personal information is limited to only achieve the service they provide and to require their use of reasonable efforts to protect your personal information.

We may disclose information about our users, and information that does not identify an individual, without restriction.

We may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this privacy policy:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Curio's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Curio about users is among the assets transferred.
- To third parties to market their products or services to you if you have consented to/not opted out of these disclosures.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government subpoena request.
- To enforce or apply our Terms and Conditions and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.

Securing Personal Information.

It is our goal, through reasonable technical, administrative and physical procedures, employee training, and safeguards to protect all personal information collected from any unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction. We will ensure that reasonable good faith efforts are utilized to secure all personal information. However, we cannot guarantee the absolute protection of all personal information. Certain events are out of our control that may present threats to your personal information, including, but not limited to, system failures, technical power outages, system failures or human errors.

The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you or where you have chosen a password for access to certain parts of the Services, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of your personal information transmitted to the Services. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the Services.

Your Choices Regarding Personal Information.

We may, from time to time, send you emails detailing various services that we have to offer. You may, at any time, email us at support@curio.gg to indicate you are no longer interested in receiving such emails or you may follow the unsubscribe instructions provided in all emails you may receive from us. However, indication of such a preference to receive emails regarding Curio's services shall not preclude us from emailing you regarding notices of any updates to this Privacy Policy and our Terms and Conditions.

We may, from time to time, send you push notifications based on your preferences to your mobile device. You can turn off certain push notifications in the account settings found in the Curio mobile app. You may also turn off push notifications specific to Curio's operations in the settings of your iOS device or through the application manager in your Android device.

You may cease all collection of your personal information by the Curio iOS and Android application by uninstalling the Curio application in accordance with the standard uninstall process applicable to your device.

Underage Individuals.

The Curio website and application are not in any way intended for any individuals under the age of eighteen (18). No one under the age of eighteen (18) may use the Services. Curio does not knowingly obtain or maintain any personal information from any individual under the age of eighteen (18) through the Services. If you are under eighteen (18), do not provide any information through the Services. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from an individual under the age of eighteen (18), we will delete such information from the Curio database as quickly as reasonably possible if allowed by law. If you believe we might have any information from or about an individual under eighteen (18), please contact us at team@curio.gg.

Law and Jurisdiction.

California residents have certain rights regarding personal information under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA). These rights are as follows:

- The right to request information about personal data that we obtain, use, and disclose as required.
- The right to request the deletion of your personal information. Such requests are subject to certain conditions.
- The right to opt out of the sale of your personal information.
- The right not to be discriminated against for exercising your CCPA rights.

California residents may contact us via one of the methods listed under “How to Contact Us” regarding their CCPA rights.

All requests will be responded to no later than 45 days.

Changes and Updates to this Privacy Policy.

We reserve the right, in our sole discretion, to periodically update this Privacy Policy as we deem fit. Any change made to this Privacy Policy shall be effective upon the posting of the revised Privacy Policy on the Services. In the event an update to this Privacy Policy is deemed, in our sole discretion, to be a material change, we will notify you of such change via email. Otherwise, you are solely responsible for reviewing and understanding this Privacy Policy as it is updated from time to time.
